

Board of Directors Meeting – September 24, 2014

Present: President- Nathan Sponseller (First State Bank/Merchant Herald/Stonehouse Inn), Recording Secretary- Tom Wills (Wills Gallery and Books/Merchant Herald), Mary Hockenbery (Mary Hockenbery Photography/Church of Art) and Rhonda Duclo (Hotchkiss Public Library). Absent: Vice President – Bill Long (TDS Telecom), Corresponding secretary – Katherine Colwell (Colwell Cedars Retreat), Treasurer – Elaine Brett.

Treasurer's Report

It was reported that the total combined Chamber bank accounts stood at \$13,479.11 including: General Checking - \$7,035.42, Special projects - \$6,150.89 and Downtown Merchants/Improvement -\$282.80. The report was approved but there was a question about what "retained earnings" meant as a line item under Liabilities and Equity on the Quickbooks printout.

Corresponding Secretary's Report

There are now 93 paid members of the Chamber with the addition of Names and Numbers phone book publisher.

Downtown Improvement

It is generally agreed that overall the 2014 Downtown flowers/planters are the best so far thanks to coordinator Mary Hockenbery and the many cooperating businesses and volunteers. The goal for the future is to steadily move the project towards routine sustainability with certain planters being maintained by specific businesses/volunteers/local non-profits on a year to year basis.

Tom Wills reported that several new projects are being considered including installing decorative, flat-style bike racks at the post office and First State Bank corners. Also, continued work on the Barnie Fair Alley Park including signage and beginning work on a paver patio surface.

Welcome to Hotchkiss Sign Replacement – Call for Artists

The Hotchkiss Chamber of Commerce is putting out a call for Hotchkiss and Valley artists to submit designs and bids for doing a Welcome to Hotchkiss sign to replace the wind damaged one on the east Hwy 133 end of town. A pre-made 10 by 12 foot panel is being provided to the artist. The maximum bid cannot exceed \$1,000. The selected design will be eye catching, creative and colorful; something that would seem appropriate for both the Friendliest Town Around and the gateway for the North Fork Creative District.
